1. James Goff (licensed victualler, publican)

Born c1776 Middlesex.

Died 29/11/1850 Pimlico, Westminster, London buried 4/12/1850 Brompton Cemetery, Westminster.

Married 9/6/1802 at St. Martins in the Fields, Westminster **Dorothy Chidlaw** born 1777 Bala, Merionethshire, Wales died 17/10/1844 Belgravia, London.

ii Maria Walker 13/1/1806 baptised 23/3/1806 at St. Marylebone, London (housekeeper) died 14/5/1876 Pimlico, London buried 18/5/1876 Brompton cemetery.

iii James Copeland 30/5/1809 baptised 1810 at St. Marylebone, London (upholsterer married Catherine) died 24/9/1887 Pimlico. 5 children.

iv Charles Phillips 17/3/1817 baptised 24/3/1820 Islington, Middlesex (undertaker married at St. James Westminster, Elspeth Ann James) died 26/12/1886 Pimlico. 4 children.

2. Eliza Chidlaw Goff

Born 23/3/1804, baptised 30/5/1804 St. Mary's St. Marylebone, London.

Died 4/3/1844 Belgrave, London. Buried 17/3/1844 All Souls Cemetery, Kensal Green, London.

Married 27/11/1834 at St. Georges Hanover Square, London **William James** (butler, musician b.1810 Donhead St. Mary, Wiltshire).

(3) i **Eliza Chidlaw** 11/6/1836 St. Georges Hanover Square, London (married **John Skinner Box**) d.1926 East Malvern, Victoria, Australia.

Emigrated to Victoria, Australia on the *Aloe* arr. in Melbourne 6/11/1858

ii Sarah Maria 2/8/1839 baptised 25/8/1839 St. Georges Hanover Square, Westminster and St Peter's Pimlico, Westminster (musician, performer, teacher, married 13/5/1865 at Trinity Church East Melbourne, Victoria, Australia, William Welchman farm manager) died 28/12/1890 Harrisville, Queensland Australia buried 29/12/1890 at Ipswich Cemetery Queensland. 1 child.

Emigrated to Victoria, Australia with her sister on the *Aloe* arrived in Melbourne 6/11/1858
