v Sarah Ann 1859 Ballarat (married William Arthur Porter civil servant) died 1943 West Brunswick, Victoria. 6 children.

vi Sophia Elizabeth 1861 Mt. Beckworth Victoria (costumier married 12/7/1886 at North Carlton, Victoria, John Harrington Langdon railway employee) died 1951 St. Kilda Victoria. 2 children.

vii Eliza Catherine 1865 Clunes Victoria (married 6/11/1893 at South Yarra Victoria, Samuel Joseph Lanceter assistant manager) died 1951 Caulfield Victoria. 3 children.

(3) viii **Fanny Caroline** 1867 - 1941 (married **George Vining Rogers**) See below.
